PRIVATE SCHOOLS SHARED SERVICES

The Board will provide the opportunity for students enrolled in eligible private schools to participate in federal programs where private school participation is required on an equitable basis with public school students. Those private schools determined by the Alabama State Department of Education as having met all applicable standards and to be in compliance with all federal regulations will be deemed eligible to participate in federal programs operated by the Board.

STUDENT TEACHING AND INTERNSHIPS

The Board shall cooperate with accredited colleges and universities for the training of student teachers to the extent that such training will both enhance educational opportunities for the classroom students as well as provide a training opportunity for the student teacher.

The administration is authorized to accept or reject requests for placement of student teachers and interns based on its assessment of the ultimate impact of such placements on the school or school district.

EDUCATIONAL ACCREDITATION AGENCY RELATIONS

It shall be the policy of the Board to establish and maintain membership for its schools in the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, cooperating in the Association's evaluations of the School System and considering its recommendations. All School System personnel shall perform assigned accreditation-related tasks in a prompt, competent, and professional manner.
