

PTA Board Meeting  
October 8, 2007  
Minutes

- Meeting was called to order at 8:30 by Heather Sandifer.
- Meeting was opened with an inspirational message from Jenine Kilgore.
- Secretary's report- *Tanya Simon*: Roll was called. 23 members present. September minutes were accepted and approved. **The November board meeting was re-scheduled for Friday, Nov. 9<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 am**, Int. amphitheater. (due to a holiday on the regular meeting date)
- Treasurer's report- *Tara Buchanan*: Bank balance reported as \$139,280.19. We still have to pay the balance for our fundraiser. Our catalog sales were \$66,963.99. Last month each side purchased new popcorn machines from the Friday Freeze funds.

- Art report- *Kelly Smith*: **Motion was made** by Kelly to approve Int. art supply purchases: drawing paper 4 packs- \$194.6, acrylic paint 10 colors- \$300.8, drawing pencils 50- \$40., clay 23 boxes-\$461.61; totaling \$997.01 out of a \$1,000.00 budget. Motion approved 23/ oppose 0.
