

Art 1 Required Supply List:

- Three Ring Binder
- College Ruled Notebook Paper
- Non Mechanical Pencils / Drawing Pencils

Materials that could also be useful but **Not Required**:

- Pencil Pouch

Digital Photography 1 Required Supply List:

- Digital Camera, must be digital. **NO film cameras, I-Pads or Cellphones, these will NOT be accepted.**
- One Thumb drive/ flash drive at least 16GB
- One 16GB memory card for their specific camera.
- Binder or folder

Additional Materials that could be helpful, but are not required:

- Memory Card Reader for uploading picture files to home computers (make sure it's compatible with your memory card size). These can be found on Amazon and at most stores like Target, Wal-Mart or Best Buy.
- Tripod for home use (however there are school ones available for check out)
- Camera bag (I know these cameras are expensive, better they can protect it!)

** The Digital Camera can be any brand or model, it's up to the student and the parents/guardians the level of investment they would like to put into this supply. Students have used everything from a point and shoot to a large DSLR camera. Brands and models will vary between students. Several students may use a parent or grandparents camera which is also fine. Students will need to bring the camera to school on certain days but not every day.

Advanced Digital Photography 2 and 3 Required Supply List:

- Digital Camera, must be digital. **Students at the advanced level really should have a DSLR camera with full manual setting. Point and Shoot cameras are not recommended.**
- One Thumb drive/ flash drive at least 16GB
- One 32GB memory card for their specific camera.
- Binder or folder
- Memory Card Reader for uploading picture files to home computers (make sure it's compatible with your memory card size). These can be found on Amazon and at most stores like Target, Wal-Mart or Best Buy.
