### **Welcome to the HTMS Summer Reading Challenge of 2021!**

You will have a chance to win popsicles, a grand prize, but most of all--KNOWLEDGE if you participate in our summer reading challenge this year.

#### **TO PARTICIPATE:**

Each student **will print out the BINGO board on pg. 2 of this document or draw the BINGO board on a piece of paper.** There will be prizes for each BINGO completed, and students can check each box as they complete it throughout the summer. The printed page will be turned into the student's ELA teacher during the first week of school.

#### **BOOK ACCESS:**

Students may check out book in several different ways:

1. Use the school [SORA app](#) and sign in using Clever
2. Use books from home
3. Check out books from the Trussville Public Library (either in person or online)
4. Use online books and/or audiobooks

#### **PRIZES:**

**ONE BINGO** = Popsicle party and 1 ticket for grand prize drawing

**EACH EXTRA BINGO** = 2 tickets for grand prize drawing

**COMPLETION OF TRUSSVILLE LIBRARY SUMMER READING** = 10 tickets for grand prize drawing

### **TRUSSVILLE LIBRARY SUMMER READING PROGRAM**
