PERMISSION TO RIDE A DIFFERENT SCHOOL BUS OR USE A DIFFERENT STOP ON THE ROUTE

Our school system's Transportation Department is required by ALSDE regulations to account for all students on each school bus. Unauthorized passengers are not permitted on the bus. However, the Transportation Department recognizes that circumstances may arise where <u>long term child care is needed</u> and a student needs to ride a different bus or use a different stop on their zoned bus (birthday parties, sleep-overs, etc. are not permitted).

Approval to ride is based upon the space available on the bus and is given on a case-by-case basis. If you have any questions, please contact the administration at your child's school.

The student will give this form to the bus driver and the bus driver will keep this form with the other bus cards. The form serves as an accountability measure for student counts, in the event of an emergency situation.
